Class 3 NOVICE NOVICE COMBINED TRAINING/SHOWJUMPING (2 phase)

Fences approx. 60cm. Open to all horses and riders provided that the combination has never been placed 1st more than two times in any showjumping competition.

Class 4 NOVICE COMBINED TRAINING/SHOWJUMPING (2 phase)

Fences approx. 75cm. Open to all horses and riders provided that the combination has never been placed 1st more than three times in any showjumping competition.

Class 5 NOVICE OPEN COMBINED TRAINING /SHOWJUMPING (2 phase)

Fences approx. 80cm. Open to all horses and riders.

Class 6 INTERMEDIATE COMBINED TRAINING /SHOWJUMPING (2 phase)

Fences approx. 85cm. Open to all horses and riders.

Class 7 OPEN COMBINED TRAINING/SHOWJUMPING (2 phase)

Fences approx. 90cm. Open to all horses and riders

1. ENTRIES

A separate entry form and fee is required for each competition **ENTRIES CLOSE ON THE FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION**; withdrawals should be received the Saturday prior to the competition.

If you enter the combined training classes then you will be automatically entered into the showjumping class.

Cancellation – if the competition is cancelled entry fees will be refunded. Paypal refunds will be net of an admin fee of 70p (to cover Paypal charge).

Dressage Start fee: There is a start fee of £1 per test which is passed to our dressage judges. **Please leave in the box in the garage on arrival**

1. ELIGIBILITY

Dressage: You can do dressage class(es) only, . Horses competing in Class 1 must not have more than 49 BD points.

Combined Training: You can pair class 1 or class 2 dressage with any jumping class.

Showjumping (2 phase): the combined training round will be judged over the 1st phase of the course (normally fence 1-8), then if no faults are incurred you will carry on to complete the remainder of the course against the clock for the showjumping round.

2. STARTING TIMES

Dressage start times will be available on www.fvrc.co.uk on the Monday morning prior to the competition. If the website is not available or you cannot access it you can obtain your start time between **9pm** and **10pm** on the Sunday prior to the competition by telephoning **Linda Lucey 01259 752572**

3. **PRIZES:** Rosettes will be awarded in all classes to 6th place.

4. **MEMBERS POINTS SERIES:** Points will be awarded to members in each class: 1st 10 2nd 8 3rd 5 4th 3 5th 2 6th 1 and a trophy will be awarded at AGM to highest score over the season. An additional point will be added per league show attended. To be eligible for points, riders must be a member before the competition in question, anyone joining on the night of a competition will not be eligible for points that night. Winners of the Novice Novice and Novice leagues are not eligible for the Novice Novice or Novice leagues respectively in the year following their win.

6. ADVERSE WEATHER

Showjumping Rules: Show will be run in accordance with British Showjumping rules (fence down = 4 faults, 1 stop = 4 faults, 2 stops = Elimination). A hat conforming to current BRC rules (www.britishridingclubs.org.uk) and appropriate footwear (riding or jodhpur boots, no wellies or trainers) must be worn. Long whips not allowed.

- 2 phase: first round and jump-off are held together. Complete the round of jumps (not against the clock). If you go clear you go straight onto the jump off phase (which will be written on the declaration board) against the clock. If you are not clear after the first round, a bell will heard and you leave the ring.
- Horse and rider combinations may only compete in a maximum of 3 consecutive classes on any night.

Combined training scoring

We take your dressage score (expressed as a percentage) and subtract that from 100. We then add any showjumping penalties to that score to give your overall score. So for example, if you scored 62% in the dressage, that would convert to 38 penalties to take forward. If you then had 4 faults showjumping your final score would be 42. The lowest overall score wins.

COMPETITON RULES

1. The Judges decision is final. Competition runs under BE rules.
2. Horses must be 4 years old or over to compete.
3. All entries must be pre-paid, entries by phone / email will not be accepted. Entries are limited and will be taken on a first come first served basis.
4. Competitors must be properly dressed, including current standard safety hats.
5. Complaints must be given to the Secretary in writing, together with £10 deposit before prize giving. If the complaint is upheld the deposit will be refunded.
6. Dogs are allowed on the showground, but must be on a short lead at all times.
7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, or alter or cancel a class.
8. By entering the competition, competitors agree to be bound by these rules.

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organizers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organizers of any event to which these rules apply, nor British Riding Clubs, nor any agent, employee, representative of these bodies accepts liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property what so ever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way what so ever.
