Please Note – Applications open 1st March 2012, Closing date for applications 21st April 2012 all cheques made payable to Area22, they will be banked on 1st May 2012 and withdrawals on or after this date will be charged for. Please complete a separate application for each person/horse.

Important notes for Camp Application

1. Applications will only be accepted from 1st March 2012,
2. All applications received by 1st April will have equal opportunity to be allocated a space. Where there is an over subscription within this timescale, a blind ballot will be used to allocate the first 50 spaces shortly after the 1st April. Whereby a waiting list will be created using a blind ballot, any applications received after the 1st April will be allocated a slot where spaces allow or be placed on the wait list on a first come first served basis.
3. All cheques will be banked on 1st May 2012.
4. No application will be accepted without full payment.
5. No application will be accepted without the current 2012 form completed.
6. No application will be accepted without a valid, current membership no.
7. Only 1 horse per person, per application allowed.
8. All horses must remain stabled onsite for the duration of camp.
9. No horse may be left unattended, there are plenty of people to keep an eye on them if you need to leave site for any reason, please ensure you organise cover prior to leaving site.
10. No horse may be left tied up outside the stable unattended.
11. Lessons are made up of groups dependent on level, please ensure that you are accurate with your skill level. Please provide information on current level of activity for you and the horse on the application. This information is essential to ensure you are placed in groups with others at the same level.
12. Xcountry is dangerous, please ensure that you are competent and secure prior to selecting these sessions. In the event that your instructor does not deem you secure / competent to ride Xcountry you may be asked to leave the session in which case we will find an alternative session for you to join which may be more suitable. Body protectors must be worn during XC session, all hats will be checked and tagged if necessary.
13. All horses attending camp must have an up to date flu vaccination in accordance with BRC rules. Passports will be checked.
14. **IMPORTANT** - Any horse/Rider combination wishing to compete for their club in the Area 22 HT Qualifiers must notify the organisers of their intention. Under RC rules no horse/rider combination who is competing at Area HT qualifiers is allowed on the course 2 weeks prior to the event. Therefore all horse/riders combinations wishing to compete will not be allowed on the XC course from the evening of Sat 12th May onwards. Ignoring this instruction may result in disqualification of their team at the Area Qualifiers event.
